Her wry, airy drawings, full of feminine flourishes, often depict the wide-open spaces disrupted by a bit of down-home satire: a lascivious female scarecrow or the back of a road-side sign in the shape of a curvaceous woman. Earlier drawings review the artist's development, while suggesting that her barbs are sharper and her aim improved (Smith).
