McNair grew up in a small town in NC and found photography while studying anthropology at Davidson College. His photographs explore an American cultural landscape ever-changing with the forces of modernization and focus on individuals most impacted by those forces. McNair is a nationally exhibited artist, a 2016 Guggenheim Fellow, and an active Guest Lecturer at San Jose State University. His work is regularly featured in publications worldwide.
